WSAA: CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will accept and abide by the instructions given by Team Managers.
- I will behave in a manner, which reflects my position as an athlete, representing my county, school, parents and myself.
- I will remain on the site of the accommodation allocated, unless permission has given by a team manager.
- I will not invite anyone onto the premises without prior permission gained from a team manager.
- I will in accordance with the directive from the organising committee, be in my room at 10.30 p.m. and remain there until 6.30a.m., except in the case of an emergency.
- I will not consume alcohol and smoke tobacco products, whilst being a part of the Wiltshire athletics team.
- I agree to take part in the parade of teams on the Saturday of the Championship, unless competing in the afternoon.
- I will return any kit borrowed and inform team managers of how I intend to journey home from the Championship.
- I understand the consequences of failing to meet the above standards of behaviour whilst representing my county team.
- I agree to pay for any damage caused by my son / daughter, which is deemed deliberate. This will also include reimbursement to the county association of any expenditure incurred if the team management deem it necessary to send your son / daughter home.
- A family member must be available to contact anytime we are away in case of an emergency or if an athlete has to be withdrawn from the team.
