## **Wiltshire Schools Athletics Association Guidelines for Team Managers and Athletes regarding Event Timetable clashes and Qualification for FINALS.**

1. The athlete and Team Manager must decide which is the athlete's main event and make that the priority.
2. Study the Championship Timetable and try to avoid a clash of events involving a Track event and a Field event.

Where the athlete still has a clash of events they should;

- a) Warm up in good time, to make full use of any time available at the start of a Field event.
- b) Report to the Field Event when the event is starting, and ask for permission to report to your Track Event. Get a team manager to attend with you.
- c) Discuss the problem your clash of events is causing with the Field Event officials. The Athlete needs to know that;
  - i) An athlete cannot leave the event without the approval of the officials
  - ii) The officials can alter the order of attempts in any round, and they will do this if it helps the situation
  - iii) If the athlete misses a round then they have missed their attempt in that round.
  - iv) If an athlete stays at the Field Event and misses their Track Event, then they have missed out in that Track Event.
  - v) Field event Officials will advise the athlete on the likely progress of the event, and estimate how much time each round will take to complete.
  - vi) Any Athlete will need to record one valid attempt in the first 3 rounds to be considered for the final 3 rounds.
  - vii) As soon as possible after having reported to the Field event the athlete, or their Team Manager need to report to the track event officials to explain the situation.
  - viii) The Officials and your Team manager should be able to ensure that you have maximum time on your Field Event before leaving, with the approval of the Field event officials, to go to your Track event in time to compete safely in the event without causing any delay.

### **Know what you need to do to qualify for a final**

In Track Events the WINNER in each heat will qualify for the final, along with the fastest losers from the heats (the number of fastest losers is dependent upon the lanes available). In Field Events, except High Jump and Pole Vault, all competitors in INTER events will be allowed 3 attempts. All athletes achieving A COUNTY STANDARD will qualify for a further 3 attempts. If the total achieving a County Standard is less than 4, then the final 3 rounds will have a total of 4 by the next highest placed competitors. All Year 7 and JUNIOR FIELD EVENT competitors will have 3 attempts only.

### WSAA T&F Team Selection for the South West Schools Championship:

Immediately after the end of the Championships today, there will be a selection meeting to select the team that will compete at the South West Championship.

**If you wish to be considered for selection you must see Danielle Fox near the Results Hub to ensure that you have recorded your availability details.** If you wish to be considered as a Special Consideration you are required to hand a Special Consideration form to Danielle Fox, (she will be able to supply you with a form).

Please note: At the SWS Championship counties are allowed 130 entries, less events we don't enter (e.g. if we don't enter an athlete in an event our total number of entries drops to 129)

We can enter a maximum of 3 per event.

### **There is no Y7 Age group at the SWS Track & Field Championship.**

Some athletes are entered in two events, so about 90 athletes are normally selected. Unfortunately, several of these carefully selected athletes won't turn up on the day!

## WSAA Championship Rules & Essential Information 2026

In **Intermediate** and **Senior** age groups, Areas may enter a maximum of two per event. If areas have 3 (or more) athletes who have all attained National Entry Standard, all 3 (or more) can be entered. Inter and Senior athletes may enter two events

In the **Junior** age group & Year 7, areas may enter a maximum of three per event, as long as the third entry is of a good standard for that event. Junior & Year 7 athletes may enter two events, either; two track, two field or, one track and one field.

**Athletes should not compete in two long distance events e.g. 800m and 1500m etc.**

1. The Championship will be conducted under **ESAA & UKA rules**.
2. Designated numbers must be worn front and back and securely fastened by four (4) safety pins. If competing in high jump or pole vault, one number is sufficient. High jumpers normally chose to have their number on their front; pole vaulters normally chose to have their number on their back.
3. **Qualification in field events.** With the exception of high jump, pole vault, Junior and Y7 events, all competitors will be allowed three attempts. All athletes achieving county standard will qualify for a further three attempts. If the total achieving a county standard is less than four, then the number of competitors in Inter and Senior age groups taken into the final three rounds will be made up to a total of four by the next highest placed competitors.
4. All Junior Age and Year 7 Age group athletes will have three attempts only.
5. **False starts:** Senior athletes follow the UKA / IAAF rules completely, in that they will be disqualified for any false start in individual events.  
Intermediate, Junior & Y7 athletes the rule is that each athlete may make one false start in individual events and would then be disqualified on the second personal false start.
6. **Qualification in track events:** The winner in each heat will qualify for the final, plus the stated number of fastest losers from the heats.
7. Athletes who proceed to a final following a heat will run in lanes set by the time they record in their heat: 200m & 400m: Fastest: lane 3; 2<sup>nd</sup> (i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest): lane 4; 3<sup>rd</sup>: lane 2; 4<sup>th</sup>: lane 5; 5<sup>th</sup>: lane 1; 6<sup>th</sup>: lane 6.  
100m or lower: Fastest: lane 4; 2<sup>nd</sup> (i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest): lane 5; 3<sup>rd</sup>: lane 3; 4<sup>th</sup>: lane 6; 5<sup>th</sup>: lane 2; 6<sup>th</sup>: lane 1.
8. The maximum spike length allowed at Swindon is 6mm on the track, and for LJ, TJ, & PV and 9mm for Javelin throwers and high jumpers.
9. Starting blocks may not be used by Y7. Juniors, Intermediates and Seniors may only use starting blocks in finals.
10. Competitors must keep outside the perimeter of the track unless reporting to an event inside the track or competing. When reporting to an event, all Competitors, Team Managers and officials should take the shortest route from outside the Track to the Field Event location and not walk across the Field at any time no matter what. Everyone must take great care when reporting to an event to ensure they do not go near the throwing areas or disturb any competitors or officials.
11. **Reporting:** Competitors should report to their event a minimum of ten minutes before their event starts.
12. **Results:** Results will be displayed as soon as possible after the end of each event. We will aim to post results on our website: [www.wiltsschoolsathletics.org](http://www.wiltsschoolsathletics.org) by the 4pm of Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

## WSAA TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP 2026 Track Programme

Athletes may compete in 2 events only, i.e. one track and one field, two track, or two field.

Junior athletes are not allowed to compete in both the 800m and 1500m events. Year 7 athletes are not allowed to compete in both the 800m and the 1200m events. It is recommended that no athlete should compete in two long distance events.

## **Team Selection Policy for the Wiltshire Schools' Athletic Association**

The selection of Wiltshire County Teams is always a thoughtful process that involves careful consideration and detailed discussion. Please note that all decisions made by the Selection Committee are final.

The Selection Committee comprises a minimum of:

- A Chairman of selectors
- A Secretary of selectors
- A Senior Team Manager
- Two other members

We have QR codes for each event which collect selection information, failure to complete this on the day of the event before 6pm will mean you cannot be considered for selection.

### **Track and Field Team Selection**

It is the intention of the committee to select the strongest possible teams in each age group for the South-West Schools' AA and the English Schools' AA Championships.

The Association must be made aware of any athlete who is unable to compete in any event prior to that Championship.

To be considered for selection for the English Schools' AA Championships athletes must have competed in either the Wiltshire Schools' AA Championships or South-West Schools' AA Championships – preferably both.

An athlete may compete in two individual events with a further restriction of a maximum of three Wiltshire athletes per individual event.

For the English Schools' AA Championship's, a maximum of thirty-two athletes, restricted to one individual event per athlete, will be selected to represent Wiltshire.

#### **• How we select for the South-West Schools' AA Championships:**

The Selection Committee will meet as soon as possible after the County Championships to select the Wiltshire team.

Top two would normally be selected with a performance above our county standard. NB for high jump and pole vault the selection would take into consideration the opening heights at the South- West Schools event.

The Selection Committee will decide upon the places, using its discretion, based on the current ESAA standards and Po10 rankings.

#### **• How we select for the English Schools' AA Championships:**

The Selection Committee will meet as soon as possible after the South-West Schools' AA Championships to select the Wiltshire team.

We would select winners of the South-West Schools with National standard achieved in that event or achieving national standard at Wiltshire or South-West Schools competition. Entry standards will then be next considered achieved at Wiltshire or South-West Schools competition.

Exceptional circumstances or athletes who were unable to compete at Wiltshire or SW Schools will then be considered.

If you wish to appeal the selection, this must be submitted in writing by 8pm on Sunday. Unfortunately, any appeals received after this time cannot be considered, as the team entry deadline is Monday morning.
